FINAL INSTRUCTIONS November 4, 2023

Dear Guy Fawkes Ride Participant,

Thank you for participating in the Guy Fawkes Ride. This document includes information and details to help make your ride this weekend safe and enjoyable. Please read it carefully.

PRIOR TO THE RIDE:

DRESS APROPRIATELY. Please be prepared for temperature swings, and dress in layers in a manner that ensures you are as comfortable as possible during the entire ride. Bring a change of clothes and ample outer layers for the post ride festivities.

FILL YOUR BOTTLES. Please fill your bottles at home, and save time by being prepared to ride. We will not have supplies at the start. There aren't any aid stations on the course, so you need to be prepared for the entire ride.

PARKING. Free parking is available at:

You may park in public spots on the side of the brewery's building as well as curbside on Appletree Lane. We may also have access to a parking lot at a neighboring business. Please follow the directions of the parking crew.

SIGN-IN. Each participant must check in personally before the ride

RESTROOMS.

Start & Finish: There are portolets located in Bucks County Brewery's parking lot and a restroom within the brewery.

RIDING THE EVENT:

REMINDER. This is a RIDE and NOT A RACE. The roads are completely open to traffic. Ride in a manner

that is safe for yourself, obeys traffic rules, and is courteous to your fellow riders and other road users.

START TIME. Riders may start anytime after they check in within the following windows:

Long Course (49-Miles): 9:00AM – 9:30AM
Short Course (28-Miles): 9:30AM – 10:00AM

START LOCATION. In the driveway at:

AID STATION. There is none.

COURSE CLOSURE TIME. All riders must finish by 2:30PM.

MECHANICAL SUPPORT. There is none. Please make sure your bike is in working order, that you have your own spare tubes and tools. The Broom Wagon Driver or Sweep Riders may be available to assist, but they are not professional mechanics. The Broom Wagon will have a pump, and a limited number of spare tubes.

SAG SUPPORT. If you are unable to finish the event for some physical or mechanical reason, call the event hotline at 267-894-0840, who will contact the broom wagon. You will be picked up as soon as feasible and transported back to the finish line as required by the demands of the event. Please keep in mind that this is a broom wagon and not a door-to-door taxi service. Assistance will come as soon as possible.

ROUTE MARKING. There is none! We highly suggest using the provided GPS Data and Official Cue Sheets.

RULES OF THE ROAD. Please remember that you are on open roads during the entire ride. All cyclists must obey all traffic laws; this includes – but is not limited to – traffic lights and stop signs. Violators may be ticketed by local law enforcement and/or disqualified and removed from the event. All riders are personally responsible for knowing Pennsylvania’s traffic laws

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY. If you have-or witness—a serious crash or medical emergency, immediately call 911, and then call the event hotline at 267-894-0840. Secure the area to the best of your ability, but do not put yourself or others in danger while you wait for emergency personnel.

KEY COURSE POINTS: Please see the cue sheet attached to this message for detailed directions. Some of the roads are rough or have a lot of pot holes (which may be filled with water). If you see a puddle, assume it is a deep pothole. POT HOLES AND OTHER ROAD DEFECTS ARE NOT MARKED. You should expect gravel and other debris in every turn.

SIGN-IN. When you finish your ride, please back sign-in; this is one way we try to keep track of who is still out on course. You will receive your ticket for a complimentary beer when you check back in.

POST-RIDE FESTIVITIES.

After your ride, we’ll provide you a ticket for a complimentary beer sponsored from [Bucks County Brewery](#). We’ll also have complimentary water and soft drinks available, on a self-serve basis. We’ll have a few snacks you can eat.

In the afternoon, the [Thai Chai Chak](#) Food Truck will be on-site at the brewery on ride day, so participants and their guests can purchase their own food.

Additional Beer may be purchased from the brewery at your expense.

Please bring a change of clothes with you with ample outer layers.

THE BOTTOM LINE. Be Safe & Have Fun. This is what this event is all about.
